Pécs has played a remarkable role during the EUROPA CANTAT XVIII Torino 2012 Festival from 27th July to 5th August. Many members of the organizing committee of the next EC not only had the chance to look behind the scenes but also actively work for the success of the current EUROPA CANTAT, solving everyday issues of the festival as members of the YEMP – Young Event Management Program and as international volunteers in the Festival- and Music Offices.

The City of Pécs had its own booth at the Music EXPO, where a presentation and a reception also had been held. The pavilion offered glimpses of the milestones of Pécs's choral culture along with some delicious cuisine and the best of the local wines to taste.

The visitors of the booth had the opportunity to write a reason or a comment on a special message board in their own languages, explaining in keywords why would they come to Pécs in three years' time. At the end of the week the board was covered with messages from all over the world.

All present guests and VIPs could experience Hungarian hospitality at the reception held by the Mayor of Pécs, dr. Zsolt Páva on 4th August. The Mayor along with dr. Péter Hoppál, MP and the Chairman of the Cultural Committee of Pécs visited the closing days of the festival in Torino and met also the Mayor of the City of Torino to exchange experience. The reception witnessed the performance of a modified version of Brahms' Hungarian Dance No.5, sang by the Béla Bartók Male Choir conducted by Tamás Lakner.

Pécs gained even more attention by being one of the main treats at the Closing Ceremony of the EUROPA CANTAT 2012. A medley of traditional Hungarian music and dances was performed by members of the Béla Bartók Male Choir, the Mecsek Folk Dance Ensemble and the 'A Köztársaság Bandája' folk music band, followed by an Open Singing session also in Hungarian. The Mayor of Pécs, at the end of the Ceremony received the flag from his Italian colleague and invited everyone to Pécs, a city where everybody is Hung(a)ry for Singing!
